Dear Parents,

Last week, a total of 465 H1N1 vaccinations were given to students and faculty over a course of three days. This mission could not have been accomplished without the following volunteers and staff: Mary Jo Fritz, Val Gerlach RN, Mary O'Brien RN, Melody Bennett RN, Abby Cronin RN, Jan Zerega RN, Karen Howard RN, Carol Albertelli RN, Michelle Fritz and Connie Oster.

Our School Office staff did their usual marvelous job of providing support. Thank you to Mrs. Collmeyer, Mrs. Reisel, and Mrs. Goedecker.

Vaccination Cards were sent home on Monday, November 16th to students 10 years and older. Children 9 years and younger will require a 2nd dose of the H1N1 vaccine to establish full immunity. The 2nd dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose. The earliest this will be given is December 11th. At this time we cannot determine exactly when we will be administering the 2nd dose because of uncertain vaccine availability. In the coming weeks, you will be notified of when we will begin the vaccinations. For those students 9 years and younger, we will send home Vaccination Cards after the 2nd dose is given.

Lastly, we would like to thank all of the parents for their strong support in keeping the students healthy during these first three months of school. As we enter the winter months, please remember to dress your children in appropriate attire for outdoor recess.
